



Harpers Ferry, Antietam, Frederick

One Day Tour of three Civil War Sites!

Experience a one day trip to Harpers Ferry, Antietam, and Frederick, Maryland that offers a powerful blend of history and scenery, from John Brown's legacy to the site of the war's bloodiest day. It concludes at the National Museum of Civil War Medicine, tying the experience together through the human stories and medical innovations of the era.



Start your day by traveling to **Harper's Ferry, West Virginia** located at the confluence of the Potomac and Shenandoah river. Explore this National Historical Park known for its strategic importance during the Civil War and the 1859 raid led by abolitionist John Brown. Visitors can explore historic buildings, museums.



Return to the buses to travel to Antietam National Military Park, where you will enjoy a boxed lunch from one of Gettysburg local restaurants.



After lunch enjoy a Battlefield Tour of **Antietam National Military Park**. Walk the famous cornfields, bloody lane, and Burnside's Bridge where the single bloodiest day of the war unfolded.



From Antietam travel to Frederick, MD and visit the **Museum of Civil War Medicine**. Visit a museum dedicated to telling the medical story of the Civil War - a story of care and healing, courage and devotion amidst death and destruction, while laying the foundation for modern medical care.

Finish your day with a hearty meal at the **Carriage House Inn** which serves Classic American fare & seafood in a landmark 1857 building with stone fireplace & period furniture .
