Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center

Explore the museum's 12 galleries, featuring artifacts, interactive displays, and special exhibits. Enjoy the immersive 15-minute film, "A New Birth of Freedom," and then step onto the cyclorama platform to view the Battle of Gettysburg Cyclorama (highlighting Pickett's Charge).



2-Hour Battlefield Tour

A Licensed Battlefield Guide will board your bus right from the Visitor Center and tell you the history on the battlefield. They will take you to key sites like Little Round Top, Culp's Hill, Pickett's Charge, and The Angle.

Civilian Life in the Crossfire

See the sights and hear the stories of the civilian experience during the battle of Gettysburg. Choose from must-see museums like the Jennie Wade House (the only civilian killed during the battle), Shriver House, Seminary Ridge Museum, and Adams County Historical Society Beyond the Battle.

Soldier's National Cemetery

Visit the Soldier's National Cemetery; final resting place for more than 3,500 United States soldiers killed at Gettysburg and where President Lincoln delivered his Gettysburg Address at the cemetery's dedication on November 19, 1863.
