## World War II: American Experience

Continue your WWII experience by visiting the home and learn about the life of President Dwight Eisenhower and his First Lady Mamie Eisenhower. Enjoy a serene stroll around the farm and a guided tour of the home which remains much like it was when they were in residence.

Explore Gettysburg with a step on guide to learn about the people and places that played a part locally in WWII. You will visit a prisoner-of-war camp and learn about the intelligence camp located here for training specialized troops for psychological warfare. Listen to stories of the navy's map-making operation preparing for the invasion of Japan, and consider the scrap drive that almost took some of the battlefield's most famous monuments and much more!
